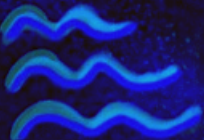
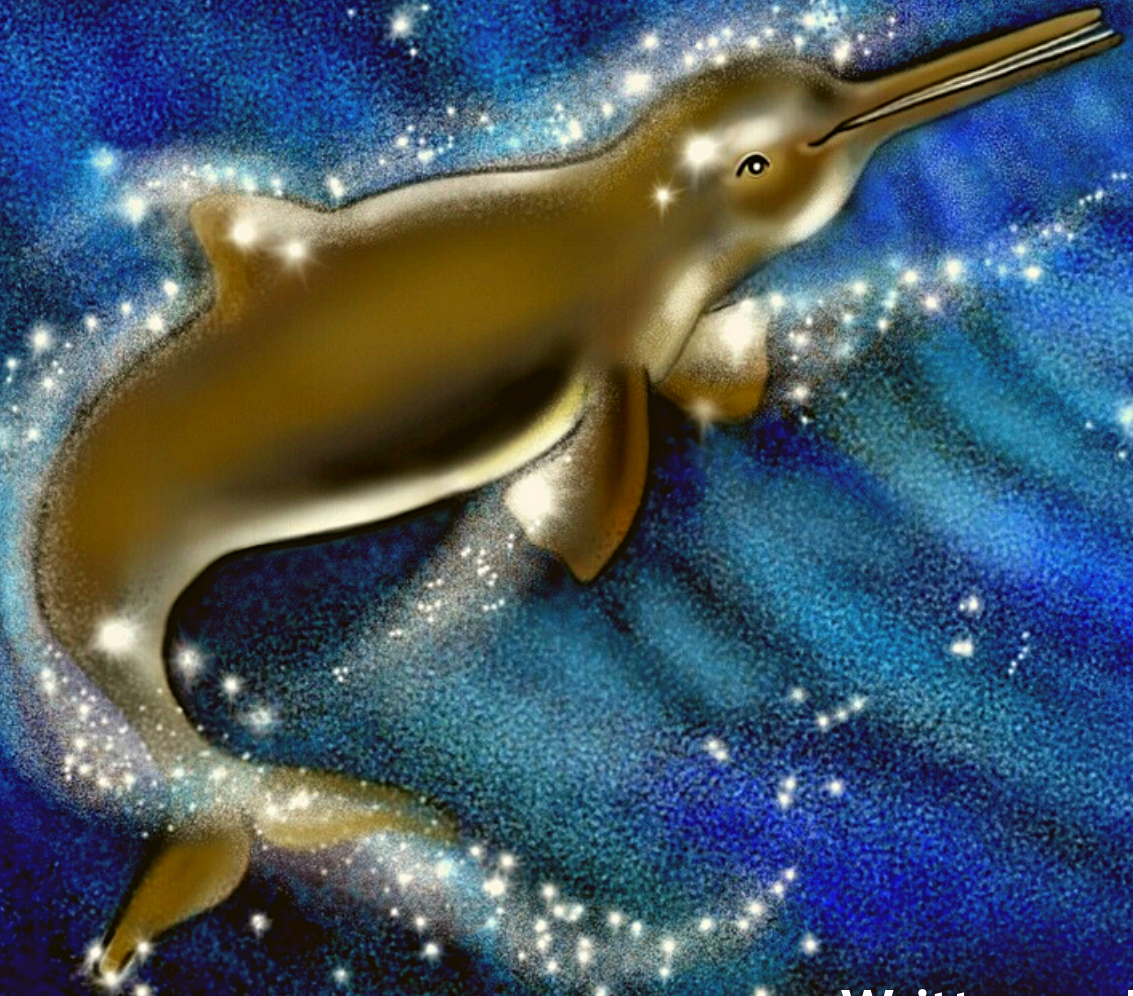


Who lives with me?
